

The current Males of Color grantees are predominantly service organizations with deep roots in their respective communities. They continue to build partnerships and collaborate with other firmly established community entities, such as local businesses, school boards, fire departments and city councils. The Foundation does this by pursuing changes in systems and policies, including changes in coordination of services, contextualization of literacy and occupation skill development, combination of on-the-job training, development of career paths, strengthening the workplace to be a learning place, and improving policies.

As the leading partner in the Mississippi Delta Workforce Funding Collaborative, the Foundation invested over \$1.8 million in pooled and

The Foundation outlined a 6-week financial training program for students participating in Mississippi Action for Community Education, Inc. (MACE) Youth Build program. The Males of Color Quality Initiative Program at the University of Arkansas Pine Bluff had a 37% increase in program participants from fall of 2014 to fall 2015. The average GPA rate was 2.58. This is above the University's average for this particular group.

Mississippi Education Reform (MER), is a collaborative of five school districts including Jackson, Hattiesburg, McComb, East Jasper and Cleveland. Collectively, MER comprises more than 40,000 students and 3,000 teachers. Of the 70 students currently enrolled in the Our Kids program, in Monroe, LA, 59 were successfully promoted to the next grade level for a pass rate of 84%. Additionally, this program, which was designed by local law enforcement officials, saw 100% of those 59 boys have no continued involvement with the criminal justice system.

Of the 28 current high school participants in the Delta Sigma Theta EMBODI program, seven of their junior/seniors were inducted into the National Honor Society.

McMillan, director of finance for the Foundation served as a presenter for the wealth building session. Mrs. McMillan's presentation included a discussion on: What is Wealth Building, Why is Wealth Building Important, Net Worth Disparity, Wealth Building Challenges, and Strategies.

Two Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) events were held in Meridian and Greenville, MS in January 2015. The Meridian event was held on January 24, 2015 from 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. at Meridian Community College. The Greenville event was held on January 31, 2015. Free tax preparation

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and financial training was provided to approximately 40 people. The events partners included: FDIC Alliance for Economic Inclusion, Mississippi State University Extension Service, VITA sites, local financial institutions, and Internal Revenue Service.
